

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSION PROCESS

APPLY:

- 1. Complete I-20 Application
- 2. Scan and email a copy of valid, current passport
- 3. Scan and email a copy of mail with home address
- 4. Submit Official Financial Verification
- 5. Pay International Student Processing Fee to Cirrus Aviation
- 6. Review International Student Checklist

OBTAIN M-1 VISA:

- 1. Receive Signed I-20 Form and Admission Letter from Cirrus Aviation
 - a. Once received, you must pay for the I-20 a fee of \$350 at the following website: <u>www.FMJfee.com</u>. This payment process is called the I-901 Form and Fee
 - b. Keep a printed copy of the I-901 payment receipt for the visa interview
 - c. Keep the Admission Letter from Cirrus Aviation for your visa interview
- 2. Interview with US Embassy in home country
 - a. Schedule Interview -- Visit your local Embassy or Consulate online for more information and go to <u>http://www.usembassy.gov</u> to find your country
 - b. Review the Interview Preparation for Visa Guide
 - c. Pay the visa application fee from your local Consulate or Embassy website -- Keep printed copy of the receipt for visa interview
- 3. Once received, scan copy of M-1 Visa and send to Cirrus Aviation
- 4. Wire \$5000 deposit

MAKE TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS:

- 1. Purchase Airline Tickets
 - a. Choose travel dates based on starting and ending dates
 - b. Arrive into Sarasota/Bradenton International Airport (SRQ) if possible
 - c. E-mail travel itinerary to Cirrus Aviation
- 2. Make Housing Accommodations -- Please contact us if you need information about availability
- 3. Arrange for Transportation During Stay -- Purchasing a used car or an electric bike is recommended, although UBER/Lyft are available

REGISTER WITH TSA (Transportation Security Administration):

- 1. Create online account -- Go to <u>www.flightschoolcandidates.gov</u> to start
- 2. Follow TSA Guide
- 3. Final Approval will be received shortly after fingerprinting is submitted



ARRIVAL & CHECK-IN:

- 1. Arrange for Pickup from Airport
 - a. If arriving into Sarasota, contact us one week prior to arrival for transportation from the airport to your housing
 - b. If arriving into Tampa, Orlando or Miami, arrange shuttle/UBER/Lyft transportation to Sarasota
- 2. Check in to Housing
- 3. Check in with Cirrus Aviation
 - a. Meet and greet with Chief Flight Instructor
 - b. Purchase study materials
 - c. Get fingerprints to finish TSA
 - d. Plan appointment for FAA Medical (register with <u>https://medxpress.faa.gov/medxpress/</u>)
 - e. Receive training schedule
